



Policy: Infection Control

Rational

Each denturist is accountable to provide services and maintain an environment to minimize the potential of harm to the patient. This includes proper infection control procedures.

Bylaw 71 (k) states:

71. A registrant must demonstrate, at all times, a level of knowledge which ensures the adequate protection of the public. Areas of requisite knowledge are:

(k) sterilization and infection control

(i) demonstrate aseptic techniques and environmental controls to ensure adequate hygienic environment.
